What is Universal Pre-K?

Universal Pre-K is a statewide school readiness program designed to provide a quality learning environment for children. The program builds on what children already know and provides active exploration and learning experiences.

WHAT IS NEEDED TO APPLY AND ENROLL?

All children who are 4 years old on or before July 1 of the enrolling school year are eligible to apply for enrollment.

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE NEEDED TO ENROLL:

- Wirt County Universal Pre-K Application
- Verification of a well-child exam within the last 12 months
- Proof of up-to-date immunizations
- Certified birth certificate from Department of Vital Statistics for the state where your child was born. **(Copies or birth certification from a hospital or county courthouse cannot be accepted).**
- Dental Form
- Proof of Income

All required items MUST be turned in BEFORE your child may begin school.

Transportation to and from Pre-K can be provided by Wirt County Schools.

If your child rides a bus, a parent or guardian must be at the bus stop for pick-up and drop-off. If the parent or guardian is not available, he/she must designate a person that is 18 years or older to be responsible for the child at the pick-up/drop-off point.

For a child to keep his/her slot once enrolled, faithful attendance is required by WV Policy 2525 and WV Code § 18-8-1, et seq. Excuses should be sent to the school after each absence. **In the event of lack of attendance or excessive unexcused absences, the child may be removed from enrollment.** The parent will receive notifications prior to this occurring.

Before the first day of Pre-K, the teacher will contact you to offer you the opportunity for a home and/or classroom visit. You will be provided with additional school information and forms. Rest mats are provided. Teachers ask that the parent provide a backpack, folder and a complete change of clothing to be kept at school. These clothes should be replaced as the child grows.
